Please join the Pima County Regional Flood Control District for a public open house for the Tucson Drainage/Arroyo Chico Project Increment 4 – High School Wash Storm Drain Improvements.

The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the project and to gather feedback from the community. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is preparing to start construction in January 2014.

The proposed project increment consists of the following:

- Construction of a new major drain under 8th Street from 4th Ave. to 3rd Ave., running north across the open field at Tucson High School, and terminating south of the stadium. This new storm drain will re-route flows in the existing High School Wash Storm Drain into the recently completed 8th St. Drainage Improvements.
- New catch basins to collect and remove street runoff on 3rd Ave. and 8th St.
