

Do you know what a HYDROLOGIST does?

Hydrologists figure out all these things:

- Watershed size, area, length, slope and soil types
- Stream and river capacities
- The depth and speed of water flow in our rivers
- How rainfall runoff happens
- Which areas will flood when it rains
- How to build flood-safe buildings
- How big aquifers are & how they recharge
- They measure how deep groundwater is
- They predict floods and warn people of flooding
- They manage drainage basins
- They study sediment transport
- Hydrologists work to protect riparian habitats
- They track movement of water above & below ground
