

HOW TO STAY SAFE WHEN THUNDER STORMS COME...



IF YOU ARE OUTSIDE:
Avoid open areas like ball fields
or golf courses.



Get to the lowest point of ground
and kneel or squat to minimize
contact points with the ground.

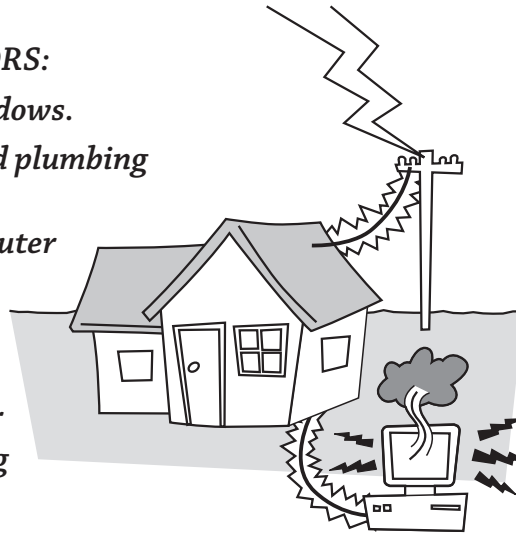
Don't stand near
trees or tall poles
when there's
lightning nearby.

IF YOU ARE INDOORS:
Stay away from windows.

Electrical wiring and plumbing
attract lightning!

Don't use your computer
or house telephone
unless it's
an emergency.

Don't wash dishes or
take a shower during
a lightning storm.



IF YOU ARE IN THE CAR:

Slow down! Water on the road may cause your car to
hydroplane. Water on roads and in washes may be deeper
than it looks. **DO NOT CROSS FLOODED WASHES.**



If you get stuck in a
wash, call 911.

If you can do so safely,
climb onto the roof of
your car and wait to be
rescued.
