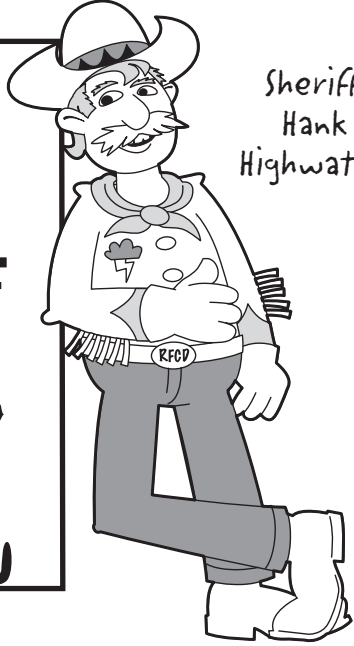


# How well do you know your State and your City?

- 7 Lakeside Park is the largest lake in Tucson. It has 14 Acres and a maximum depth of 35 feet.
